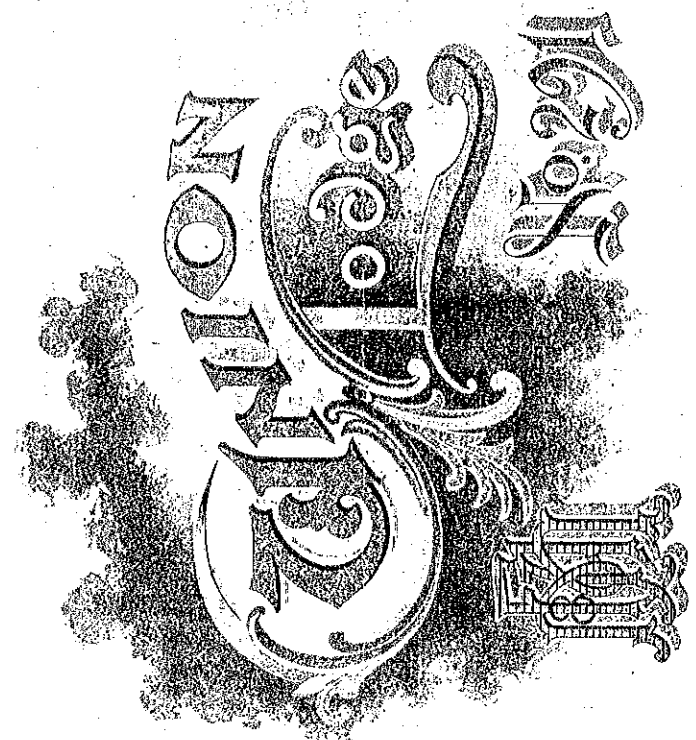

EXTRACT FROM THE BY-LAWS
 ARTICLE VI—DUES

Your Dues to December 2, 1977 (Annual Election) are \$_____

Section 1. The dues for each member shall be \$20.00 per annum except
 when otherwise provided by these By-Laws.

Sec. 2. Any member being in arrears to the Lodge for two or more years on the
 night of the annual election, and neglecting or refusing to pay the same after he has
 been summoned by action of the Lodge at the next preceding stated meeting to pay
 his arrears or show cause why he should not be suspended for non-payment, may be
 suspended from membership; Provided that before any member may be suspended,
 it shall satisfactorily appear to the Lodge that such member has, in addition to such
 summons, received due notice as required by Article III, Section 3, of these By-
 Laws, and that the provisions of the Ahiman Rezon have been fully complied with.
