Masonic Dress—White Gloves

When a Committee fails to report within FOUR (4) MONTHS the Master must declare the petition null and void, as per Article XXI, Section 3, *Alhman Rezon*.

A Lodge may act on a petition *not* exceeding four (4) months after its presentation. If the four (4) months expire at a time when the meetings are omitted the report may be made at the first stated meeting of the Lodge which shall occur thereafter. *Stated meetings omitted are to be counted.*

Extension of time is not allowed by the substitution of a new member of the Committee at the expiration of the four months.
