MASONIC MILITARY AND NAVAL SERVICE HAS HANDS ACROSS THE SEAS (From "LONDON EVENING STANDARD")

"I am told that there are about 100,000 Freemasons among the U. S. Forces in this country. A Club for these men—and also for Freemasons of the British and other English speaking armies has just been opened in Mount Street, Mayfair, formerly the home of Lord Gort.

"When I dropped in there to have a look I found Lieut. Col. Robert H. Young, who was in charge of the club, chatting with three U. S. sergeants who had just returned from Italy. Col. Young is a retired American officer who came to England recently.

"The great thing about this club is everyone drops his rank and becomes just a Freemason. Many high-ranking U. S. Officers in this country are Freemasons."
