Scranton, Pa., May 19, 1934.

A stated meeting of Union Lodge, No. 291, Free and Accepted Masons, will be held in Tuscan Hall, Masonic Temple-Scottish Rite Cathedral, 420 North Washington Avenue, Scranton, Penna., on Friday evening, June 1, 1934, at 7:30 o'clock.

Action will be had on the following proposed amendments to the By-Laws:

Resolved: That Article V, Section 1, be amended by striking out the figures "\$120.00" in the third line, and inserting in lieu thereof the figures "\$100.00"; by striking out the figures "\$75.00" in the seventh line, and inserting in lieu thereof the figures "\$60.00"; by striking out the figures "\$60.00" in the ninth line and inserting in lieu thereof the figures "\$50.00"; so that, as amended, the said section shall read as follows:

Article V, Section 1, Fees.

For initiation and Membership.....\$100.00
of which \$40.00 shall be for the Masonic Homes of the Grand Lodge.

For the admission and advancement of an Entered Apprentice
Mason\$ 60.00

For the admission and advancement of a Fellow Craft Mason.....\$ 50.00


For the admission of a Master Mason, last a member of a Lodge
under the Jurisdiction of the Grand Lodge of Pennsylvania..... no fee

For the admission of Brethren from Lodges of other Grand Jurisdictions,
\$40.00 for the Masonic Homes of the Grand Lodge of Pennsylvania.

Resolved: That Article IV, Section 1, be amended by striking out the figures "\$60.00" in the second line and inserting in lieu thereof the figures "\$50.00"; so that, as amended, the section shall read as follows:

Article IV, Section 1, Petitions.

All petitions for Initiation and Membership shall be accompanied with \$50.00; which sum shall be considered a part of the fee. If the petition be withdrawn or the petitioner rejected, the money shall be returned; but if approved and he does not come forward within six months thereafter it shall be forfeited to the Lodge.
