#### EXTRACTS FROM THE BY-LAWS

ART. II, SECTION 1. The dues of each member shall be twelve dollars per annum, except otherwise provided by these By-Laws.

SEC. 3. No member shall be entitled to vote at the annual election or be eligible to any office unless his dues shall have been paid in full to the St. John's Day next succeeding such election, or the same duly remitted by vote of the Lodge.

SEC. 4. Before proceeding to the election, the Secretary shall read a list of the members who are in arrears to the Lodge; whereupon the Master shall announce that such members are neither eligible to the office nor entitled to vote.

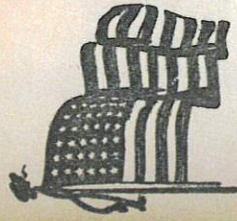
