Dear Brother:

This condensed statement is furnished you so that you may know particulars of the results of operation of the Temple-Cathedral for the year 1936.

A complete detailed report of the Auditors is in the hands of the Officers of your Bodies. Further information will be gladly furnished, upon request, by them or the Temple office.

Speaking generally, 1936 was about on a par with 1935. The return credit to the Bodies was only a few dollars less than the previous year and the cost for meeting in the Temple to most of the Bodies was less. The average for all Bodies except the Consistory (with its large membership) was below \$200.00 for the year. This is worthy of favorable comment.

Please remember that every outside rental reduces the actual maintenance cost to the Bodies. Kindly exert your personal and fraternal influence in behalf of the Temple, and advise the Temple office of prospective rentals.

With general conditions somewhat improved and with your help may we anticipate an active, interesting and prosperous 1937.

Dear Sir and Brother:

AN EDICT

WHEREAS, the attention of the Grand Master has been called to the subject of gambling enterprises sponsored by Masonic Lodges, Masonic Hall Associations, and groups of Masons to the use of Masonic Lodges and Masonic Hall Associations; and

WHEREAS, such enterprises are in violation of Federal Laws, and in some instances, of State Laws, and are thereby in violation of Masonic Law, and are an affront to Freemasonry in general.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold N. Rust, Right Worshipful Grand Master of Masons in Pennsylvania, and Masonic Jurisdiction Thereunto belonging, by virtue of the authority in me vested, do hereby order that no member of the Fraternity in this Jurisdiction shall alone, or with others, be a party to any gambling, lottery, or gift enterprise devised or arranged to raise money which shall either directly or indirectly inure to the benefit of any Masonic Lodge or Masonic Hall Association in this Jurisdiction.

This Edict is to be included as part of the next Lodge notice and is to be read in every Lodge at its next stated meeting, and is to be entered in full upon the minutes.
